## Please compost in your green bin:

- Food scraps (including citrus, onion, dairy, meat, bones, fish, fruit and vegetable scraps)
- Compostable kitchen caddy liners, must be certified compostable (as supplied through Council)
- ✓ Tea leaves and tea bags
- ✓ Coffee grounds
- Egg and oyster shells
- Tissue and paper towel
- ✓ Lawn clippings
- Weeds
- ✓ Cut flowers
- ✓ Small cuttings, prunings and branches
- ✓ Shredded paper (loose/not bagged)
- ✓ Pet waste (no plastic bags or kitty litter)
- ✓ Sawdust
- ✓ Hair and nail clippings

Many of these items can also be composted in your home compost.

Please DO NOT place any plastics including bags, irrigation pipe, hoses, bottle caps, or metals in the green organics bin.
