Once collected, place them in your **green bin**. If you live outside our green bin collection area, many of these items can be composted at home.

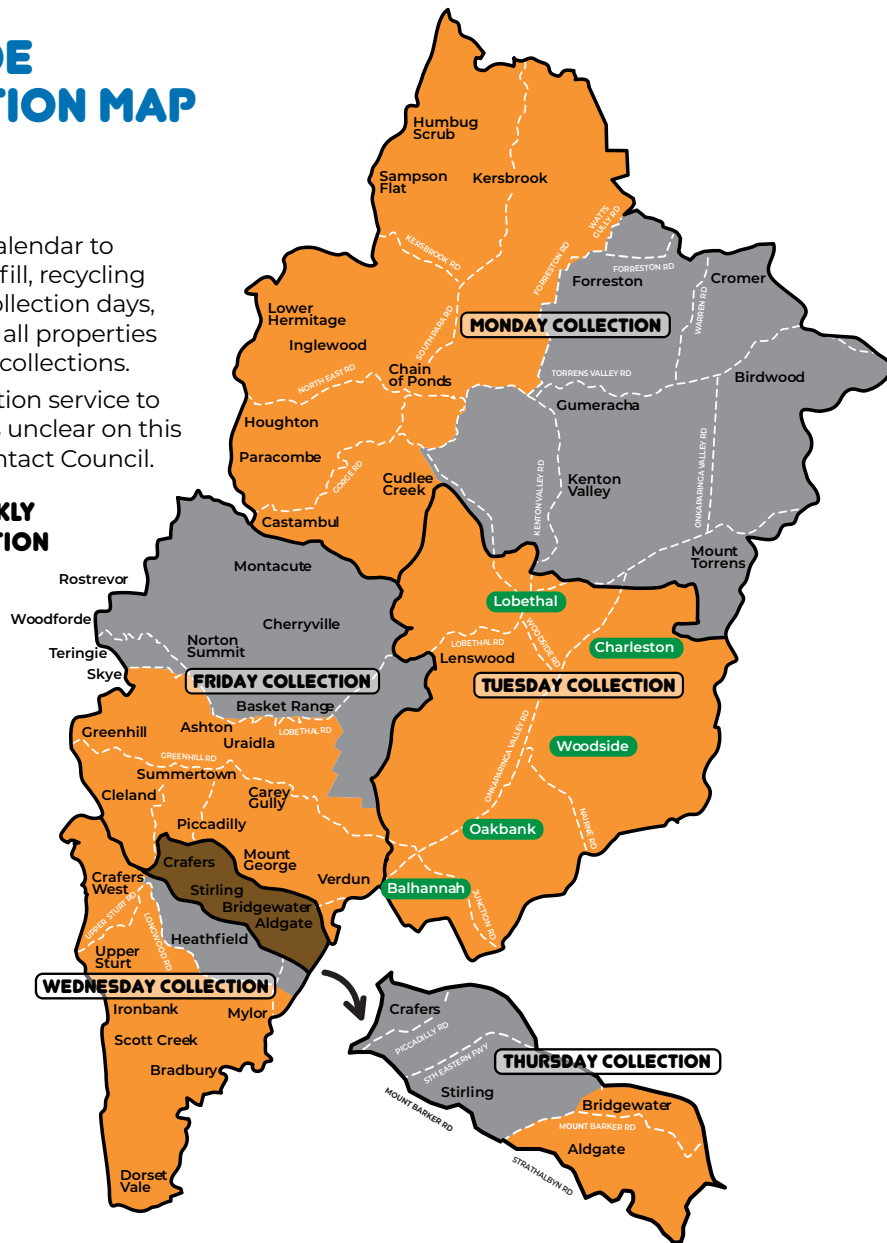
KERBSIDE COLLECTION MAP

- Green organics bin (fortnightly)
- Yellow recycling bin (fortnightly)
- Blue or red landfill bin (weekly)
- No collection - all collections move to the next day for the remaining week.
- Public holiday - collection as usual.

Place bins 1 metre apart at kerbside by 6am on your collection day. Remove bins from verge within 24hrs of collection.

Collections may be delayed on catastrophic and extreme fire danger days rated 75 or above. Please leave your bins out until collected.
