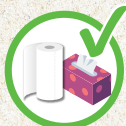

**Please
compost in
your green
bin:**

- ✓ Food scraps (including citrus, onion, dairy, meat, bones, fish, fruit and vegetable scraps)
- ✓ Compostable kitchen caddy liners, must be certified compostable (as supplied through Council)
- ✓ Tea leaves and tea bags
- ✓ Coffee grounds
- ✓ Egg and oyster shells
- ✓ Tissue and paper towel
- ✓ Lawn clippings
- ✓ Weeds
- ✓ Cut flowers
- ✓ Small cuttings, prunings and branches
- ✓ Shredded paper (loose/not bagged)
- ✓ Pet waste (no plastic bags or kitty litter)
- ✓ Sawdust
- ✓ Hair and nail clippings

**Many of these items can also be composted
in your home compost.**

**Please DO NOT place any plastics including bags,
irrigation pipe, hoses, bottle caps, or metals
in the green organics bin.**
