## Hazardous waste and e-waste drop off locations

Hazardous waste and e-waste (anything with a plug or battery) cannot be placed in any kerbside bin.

## Battery recycling

Household batteries cannot be recycled through kerbside recycling bins. Drop off at the Council Depot, Norwood Town Hall or any Council library.

## Kitchen scraps and green organic waste

Please use your green bin for all food scraps including fruit and vegetables, tea bags and coffee grounds, dairy products, egg and oyster shells, bones, meat and seafood as well as paper towel, tissues, pizza boxes and other cardboard takeaway boxes.

The Council provides residential properties with a free kitchen caddy and annual supply of compostable bags to make it easy to compost food waste through the green bin. These are available from Norwood Town Hall or any of the Council's libraries.

## My Local Services App

Get kerbside collection calendar, bin reminders, waste reduction and recycling tips on the free My Local Service App. Download from the Apple App or Google Play store.

## Kerbside bin placement

Place bins close to the gutter with the handles and wheels facing away from the road. Keep a minimum distance of 50cm between bins, and 1 metre between bins and parked cars, street trees and or stobie poles. Ensure there is plenty of clearance between the bins and any overhead braches or obstructions. Do not place any items on top of or around the bins.

Soiled pizza boxes

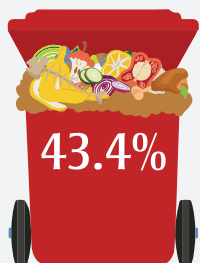
## Recycling bin

Paper and cardboard  
Rigid plastic bottles and containers  
Juice and milk cartons  
Tins and cans  
Aluminum cans  
Aluminum trays and foils  
Aerosols (empty)  
Liquid paper board cartons  
Glass bottles and containers

## General waste bin (landfill)

Soft plastics (or RedCycle)  
Polystyrene foam  
Old clothing and rags  
Single use nappies  
Broken crockery and glassware  
Ropes and hoses

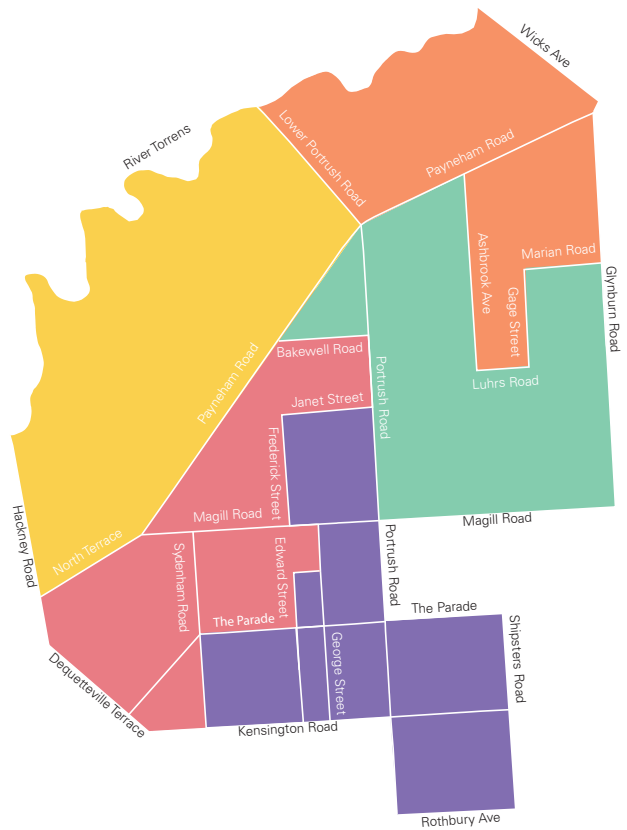
## Collection Day
